

ABSTRAK

Tujuan Penulisan skripsi ini ialah mengkaji implementasi konsep pertobatan ekologis yang termuat dalam Ensiklik *Laudato Si'* karya Paus Fransiskus, khususnya dalam kaitannya dengan gerakan pastoral ekologi di Paroki Katedral Santo Yoseph Maumere. Penelitian ini dilatarbelakangi oleh kesadaran akan pentingnya tanggung jawab moral dan spiritual umat Katolik terhadap kelestarian lingkungan hidup sebagai bagian integral dari iman kristiani.

Untuk mencapai tujuan tersebut, penulis menggunakan pendekatan kualitatif dengan metode studi pustaka dan wawancara. Studi pustaka dilakukan dengan menganalisis isi Ensiklik *Laudato Si'*, terutama bagian-bagian yang secara eksplisit maupun implisit memuat gagasan mengenai pertobatan ekologis. Sementara itu, wawancara dilakukan terhadap sejumlah narasumber yang terlibat secara langsung dalam kegiatan pastoral ekologi di paroki Katedral Santo Yoseph Maumere. Data yang dikumpulkan dianalisis secara deskriptif-kualitatif dengan tujuan memahami keterkaitan antara dokumen magisterial Gereja dan praktik pastoral di tingkat paroki.

Berdasarkan hasil penelitian ini, penulis menyimpulkan bahwa: (1) Ensiklik *Laudato Si'* memuat suatu konsep teologis tentang pertobatan ekologis sebagai panggilan spiritual untuk memperbarui relasi manusia dengan alam ciptaan; (2) konsep ini telah diimplementasikan dalam berbagai kegiatan pastoral ekologi di Paroki Katedral Santo Yoseph Maumere, antara lain melalui program edukasi lingkungan, penanaman pohon, pengelolaan sampah, serta pelaksanaan liturgi kontekstual bertema ekologi; dan (3) terdapat peningkatan kesadaran umat paroki terhadap tanggung jawab ekologis yang diwujudkan dalam partisipasi aktif pada kegiatan-kegiatan tersebut.

ABSTRACT

The purpose of writing this thesis is to examine the implementation of the concept of ecological repentance contained in Pope Francis' Encyclical concept of ecological repentance contained in relation to the ecological pastoral movement in the Cathedral Parish of Saint Joseph Maumere. This research is motivated by the awareness of the importance of the moral and spiritual responsibility of Catholics to the preservation of the environment as an integral part of the Christian faith.

To achieve this goal, the author uses a qualitative approach with literature study and interview methods. Literature studies are carried out by analyzing the content of the Encyclical Laudato S', especially those parts that explicitly and implicitly contain the idea of ecological conversion. Meanwhile, interviews were conducted with a number of resource persons who were directly involved in ecological pastoral activities in the parish of St. Joseph Maumere Cathedral. The data collected were analyzed in a descriptive-qualitative manner with the aim of understanding the relationship between the Church's magisterial documents and pastoral practices at the parish level.

Based on the results of this study, the author concludes that: (1) The Encyclical Laudato Si' contains a theological concept of ecological repentance as a spiritual call to renew the relationship between man and the created world; (2) this concept has been implemented in various ecological pastoral activities in the Cathedral Parish of Saint Joseph Maumere, including through environmental education programs, tree planting, waste management, and the implementation of contextual liturgy with an ecological theme; and (3) there is an increase in the awareness of parishioners of ecological responsibilities which is manifested in active participation in these activities.
