

ABSTRAK

Penelitian ini bertujuan, (1) menganalisis dan menjelaskan kontribusi kelompok minat THS-THM bagi penguatan pembentukan kepribadian calon imam di Seminari Tinggi Interdiosesan St. Petrus Ritapiret, (2) menjelaskan definisi dan sejarah THS-THM dan nilai-nilai yang terkandung di dalamnya, (3) menjelaskan perkembangan kelompok minat THS-THM di Seminari Tinggi Interdiosesan St. Petrus Ritapiret.

Penelitian ini menggunakan dua macam metode penelitian yakni, penelitian lapangan dan kepustakaan. Penelitian lapangan akan dilakukan dalam ruang lingkup Seminari Tinggi Interdiosesan St. Petrus Ritapiret. Dalam penelitian lapangan ini, penulis menggunakan metode kuesioner, wawancara dan observasi partisipatif.
